

## **THINGS TO BRING, AND THINGS TO KNOW, ABOUT Bair Lake QUILT CAMP**

1. Casual clothes
2. Comfy shoes (walking shoes if you plan to do any nature walks.)
3. Shampoo, soap, toothpaste and toothbrush, and all the stuff you cannot live without. Note: Sheets and towels are provided.( If you are in the dormitory in Sunshine Lodge you will need to bring your own bedding and a towel)
4. Bring your own hairdryer as they are not provided.
5. **Flashlight** may be handy if you need to walk to your room.
6. Snacks if you want, coolers with drinks are allowed. Please leave these just outside the door to our sewing space. No alcoholic beverages.
7. Favorite Mug . Must have a lid.
8. Sewing stuff - machine, thread, extra needles, scissors, etc.
9. Portable light if needed. The room appears well lit.
10. Comfy chair (folding chairs available)
11. Iron and Ironing surface (stations will be provided)
12. Umbrella in case it rains
13. Good sense of humor, and a positive attitude that you are going to have a great time

It is not necessary to bring power cords or strips. They will be provided by the guild. However, if you have one, bring it, especially if you have a very expensive machine that you want to protect with a particular surge protector.

### **CHECK IN:**

1. When you arrive at Bair Lake Camp, take the second entrance road and go to the ground floor “drop off point” on the far side of Lakeview Lodge. (see map for location). After registration move your sewing items in, then proceed to your assigned lodging. All campers staying at Lakeview lodge must then park their cars in the parking lot in front of the Pineview Adventure Center. (again refer to your map).
2. Campers staying in Sunrise Pavilion will park in the parking lot in front of Pineview Adventure Center and then drive to the parking lot beside Sunrise lodge at night. Or walk, if the weather is good!

### **Arrival Time**

If you arrive prior to lunch you will need to bring a sack lunch, as your first meal will be your dinner meal.

Arrival Times: Anytime after 10:30 AM Thursday (1st meal Thurs. night)

**Departure times:** Everyone must be completely gone from camp by 12:00pm Sunday. All campers should aim to be out by 11:30am. This will give the camp committee 30

### **MEALS:**

All meals will be served in the dining hall. Thursday dinner and Friday, Saturday breakfast and lunch and dinner, and Sunday, breakfast. Remember if you choose to arrive at 10:30 AM on Thursday, your first meal at the camp will be at 5:30 PM Thursday. Everything is self-serve. Pop is available with meals only. Tea, coffee and water are available 24 hours. Remember to use a lid on all beverages in the sewing room.
